Criteria for Junior Queen Court Contest Participation:

- ✔ Between the ages of 9 and 13, as of January 1 of this year.
- ✓ Actively involved in the GCFFY for one or more years.
- ✓ Has not previously won the Senior division.
- ✓ Must be able to attend the upcoming Fair Opening Ceremonies, to be held at 4:00 p.m., Sunday on the first day of the fair.
- ✓ Must be able to participate in royal court activities during fair week handing out ribbons; also including court photographs.
- ✓ Must be able to participate in local parades and community events during the next year representing the Gratiot County Fair for Youth.

Must participate in the following to be eligible:

- ✓ Submit an application portfolio on or before due date that includes:
 - o Application (form included in this packet), must be handwritten.
 - o Essay must be handwritten.
 - Adult Recommendation Form, completed by a non-relative (included in this packet).
- ✓ Complete an interview with the contest judges on the evening of <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>June 22</u>, <u>2022</u> <u>starting at 5:15 p.m.</u>, <u>no makeup dates or times</u>
 - Prepare for a professional style interview and dress professionally.
